Preparing to Travel Before you travel, complete the following:

• Find the name and contact number for a clinician that sees laryngectomees in the area you are visiting, and bring this information with you when you travel. Contact Atos Medical for assistance as needed.

- Bring a back-up voice prosthesis of your current size and type.
- Get a prescription from your physician so you can see another clinician in case of emergency while you are traveling.
- If you are traveling outside the country, contact Atos Medical. Atos is represented
 in many countries around the world and may be able to assist you in locating
 healthcare professionals throughout your travel. Purchasing travel insurance that
 covers medical expenses is also advised.
- A letter from your doctor may be needed to bring special medical equipment (i.e. suction, moist air, oxygen) through airport security.
